We regret to inform you that MV Santa Barbara 496/212S had a positive tested COVID19 case on board and was quarantined in Bremerhaven / Wilhelmshaven. This will delay her scheduled departure from Bremerhaven by about 10 days.

In order to soonest return to a weekly schedule the next ship in sequence the Santa Ursula 498/212S will overtake MV Santa Barbara and shall close the gap to the preceding MV Santa Isabel 494/212S
