Dear Valued Clients,

We already informed you in our Notice dd 18<sup>th</sup> May about the delayed sailing of MV Santa Barbara because of a COVID-case on board.

After having completed the necessary quarantine measures the vessel will return to service in Bremerhaven.

Unfortunately, we also have a COVID-case on MV Santa Cruz, which was planned to enter the service in Zeebrugge and load the import cargo from the Santa Rosa 976/211N. These imports for London, Bremerhaven and Algeciras will now be loaded on MV Maersk Luz (ETA Zeebrugge 26<sup>th</sup> May), which will overtake MV Santa Cruz and offer the next southbound sailing after MV Santa Barbara. We will inform you about the further schedules of Maersk Luz and Santa Cruz soonest possible.

We want to assure you that all measures will be taken to minimize the delay in arrival of your containers in South Africa and apologize for the inconvenience that these necessary contingencies may cause.
