UPDATE: TRANSNET CYBER ATTACK

Dear valued Client,

Following on from our notice of the 26th, we are pleased to report that Transnet have made good progress in their efforts to secure and re-instate its various IT systems. Transnet has over the past 3 days begun to re-introduce its operating software in a phased approach with the key focus area being the port of Durban.

The NAVIS system (port operating system) was re-introduced yesterday morning. It has been closely monitored and is deemed to be stable enough for the operational environment. As a result, the port of Durban and Cape Town are once again operating on the platform, Port Elizabeth and East London are expected to be on-line by the end of the week.

Vessels are currently being worked, with import and export cargo once again moving through the terminals. The backlog of containers is currently being addressed. While all efforts are being made to assist TPT to increase productivity, it will take some time before the terminals are operating at pre-cyber-attack levels.
