ECA SURCHARGES AS FROM 1ST OF APRIL 2015

Since January 1st 2015, all ships operating within Emission Control Areas (ECA) in the Baltic Sea, North Sea, English Channel and the coasts of Canada and USA are required to utilize fuel with significantly lower sulphur content (see our NtS dated 12/9/2014).

In order to compensate for the resulting additional costs the following surcharges will now apply as from April on all shipments to and from the ports in the defined trade routes:

These surcharges are based on current bunker prices and will be implemented for all shipments on the same voyages for which the revised April Bunker Surcharges are applicable.

DAL will continue to review the level of these surcharges on a quarterly basis and any significant fluctuations in the price for low sulphur fuels will be reflected in the surcharge levels.
