Customs Advanced Manifest Fee (CAM)**

Dear Customer,

On January 1, 2011 the European Union's Customs Advanced Manifest Rule (EU 24hr Rule) will come into effect. The legislation requires the electronic transmission of Entry Summary Declarations (ENS) for deep-sea containerized shipments, entering the EU, to be lodged at least 24 hours before commencement of loading in each foreign port. The vessel operator is responsible for lodging an ENS for all goods discharged in an EU port including transshipment goods and goods remaining on board.

This change in EU customs procedures has had a major cost impact on the ocean carrier, and in order to cover some of the operational and administrative costs DAL is forced to introduce a Customs Advanced Manifest Fee (CAM) of:

- **USD 28 per Bill of Lading for the first ENS filing**
- **USD 28 for any data amendment made after the ENS has been filed.**

This fee is applicable as from 01 January 2011 for all cargo bound for the European Union. The first vessel where this charge will be applied is the DAL Kalahari 814/111B, sailing Port Elizabeth on 06 January 2011.
